Back through the grass! Swishy swashy! Swishy swashy!



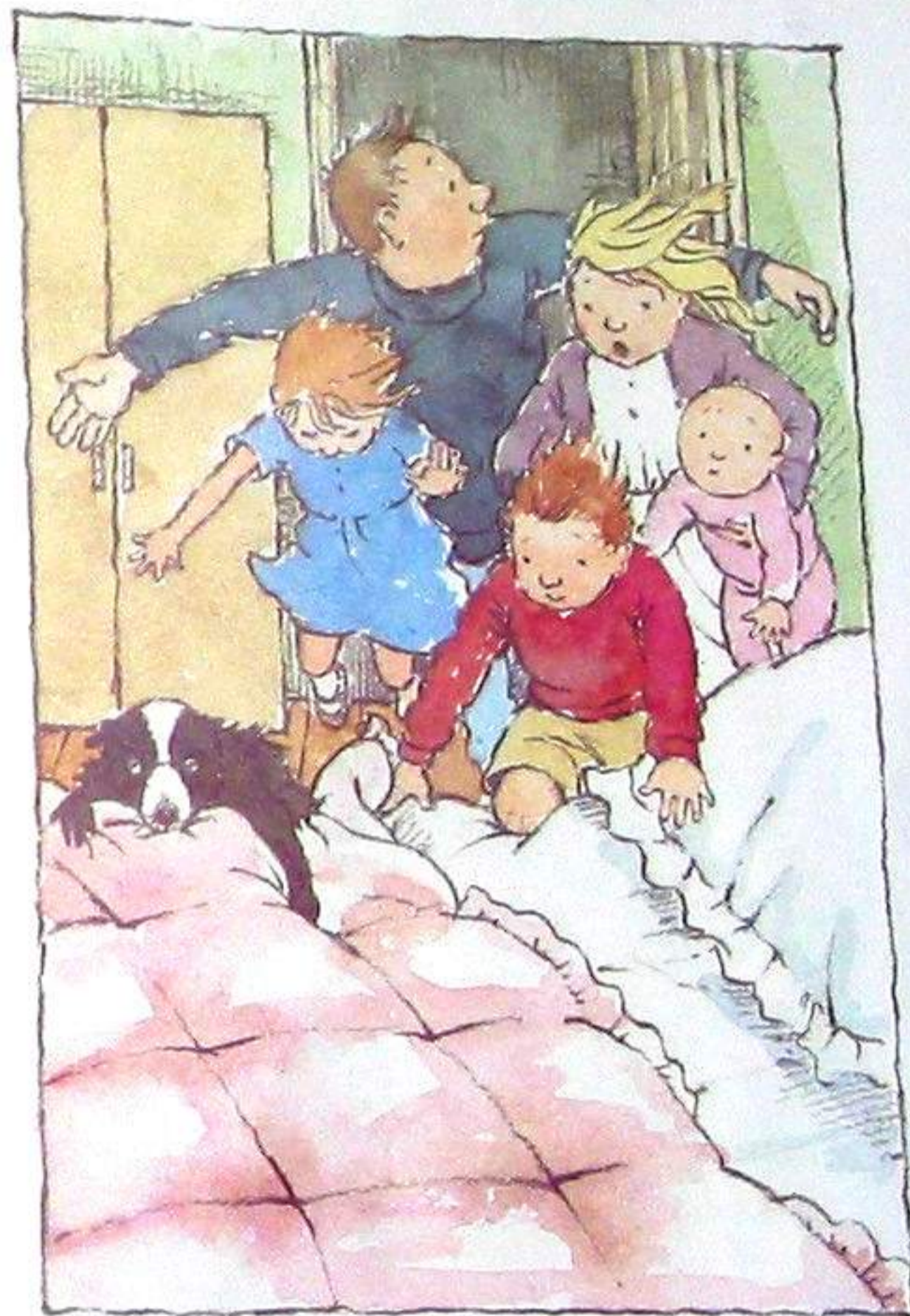
Get to our front door.

Up the stairs.



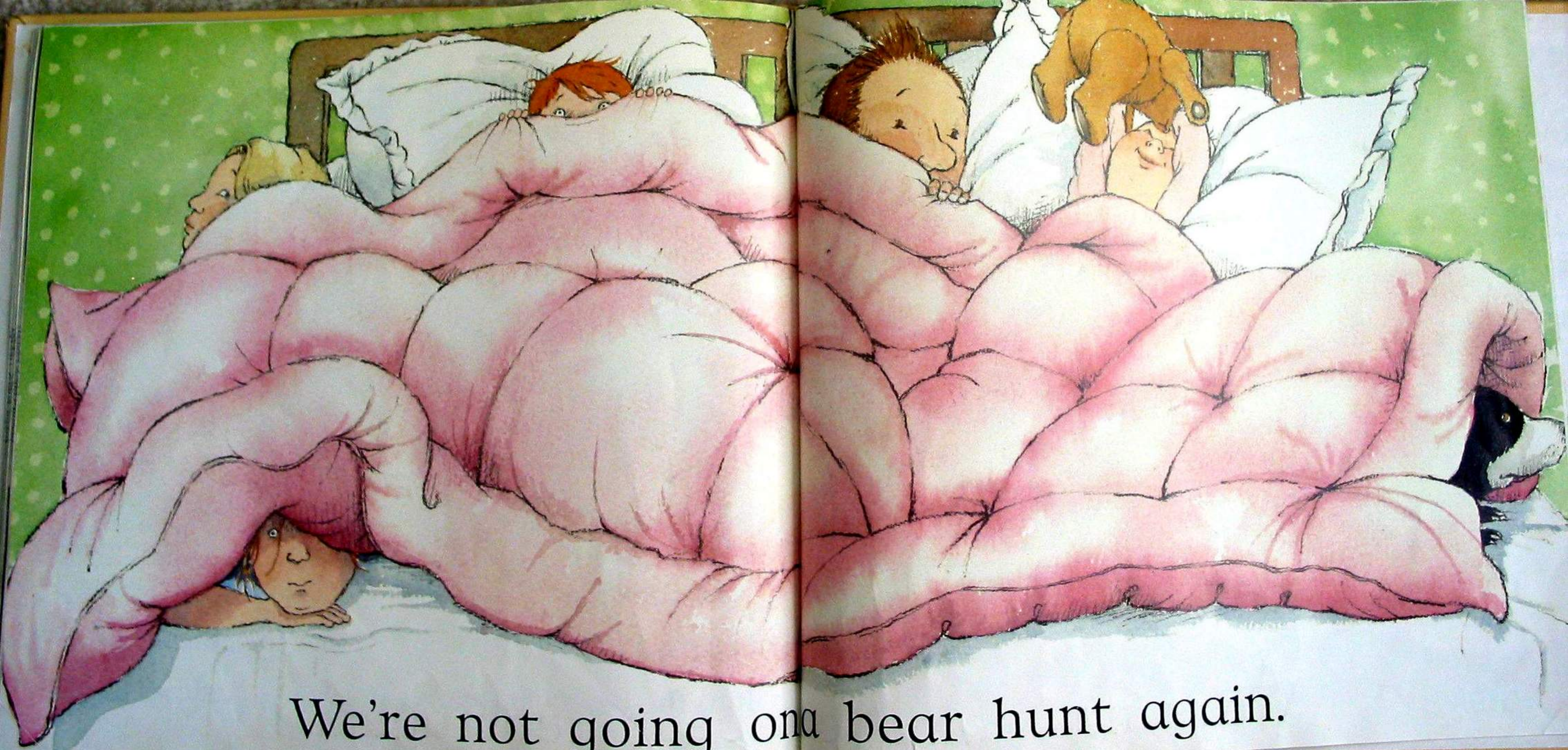
